September 10, 2024

- I. Lechowicz called the meeting to order at 7:10pm.
- II. All board members were present.
- III. The regular board meeting minutes for August were presented. Lechowicz moved, with Holt supporting, to approve the minutes. All yes.
- IV. Treasurer's Report – Byard presented the treasurer's report. The total of our bank accounts on August 31, 2024, was \$215,904.19.
- V. Prout presented the bills to be paid, totaling \$74,461.57. Lechowicz moved, with Eby supporting, to approve the payment of the bills presented. All yes.

- IV. Cemetery Trees - The board discussed options for planting more trees at the cemetery/fire hall. We will hold off on trees and consider lower plants to go between the trees already in place.
- V. Township Hall Air - The heating/cooling system is working well. No bill has been received yet.
- VI. Clerk Phone - Prout is looking into options for a phone and a service provider. Lechowicz moved, with Eby supporting, to approve up to \$500 to purchase a phone for clerk use.

### NEW BUSINESS

- I. Fire Hall Weeded - Someone weeded in the rocks by the fire hall, perhaps Nathan Paquet? Our thanks to the one who did this.
- II. Tai Chi - This will be held on Wednesdays from 10:00-11:00am.
- III. Wilderness Camp Store - The personal property tax is not being paid. The county wants to know if we want to write it off. An option would be to place a lien so the taxes would be paid if the property is sold. Lechowicz will contact Lavandar about this.
